8. Legislative Support and Grant Procedures in Healthcare

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Module Annotation

Legislative support for the provision of health services and good knowledge of grant management processes is an integral part of managers in middle and top management positions of all health and social service providers. This is a key skill that enables good orientation and the art of responding to current stimuli and challenges.

Module Objective

The aim of the module is to provide students with an introduction to the legislative support in the provision of health care and a basic orientation in the field of grant management. Healthcare and healthcare represent a set of healthcare procedures and activities that are performed by healthcare professionals and have an impact on health status. The goal of health care is to prolong the life of an individual, increase the quality of his life and the healthy development of future generations. The provision of health care in the Czech Republic has undergone a fundamental transformation since 1989. All the changes that took place after November 1989 in the health care sector had a significant impact on the system of quality and safety in the provision of health care. The post-recession development of our country has understandably also affected the healthcare system in connection with legislative

changes. Legislative changes also brought related rewrites and changes involving issues of quality and safety in the provision of health services. In connection with the need to adopt a few international treaties, the original legislation became completely inadequate. The Act on People's Health Care, No. 20/1966 Coll., replaced Act No. 372/2011 Coll. on health services and the conditions of their provision.

Grant management is an important part of the support of science, research, education and the provision of health care. The organizational component of the state or territorial self-governing unit, which decides on the provision of support and which provides this support, ensures the preparation and implementation of groups of grant projects and other activities in the field of research, including public competitions in R&D&I to support program projects, evaluation and selection of project proposals, provision of purpose-built support of grant projects on the basis of contracts on the provision of support or decisions on the provision of support, control of the fulfillment of contracts on the provision of support and drawdown of targeted support, evaluated and control of the progress of solutions and the fulfillment of project objectives and control of the results achieved by them.
